- No matter what you try in your parenting, do it with humility!

Key Takeaways:

- Don't hide from your children's doubts and fears about faith. Instead, help them to know you are always ready to hear and talk about whatever is troubling them.
- Let go of disappointment or anger when you are frustrated in parenting tweens and instead focus on giving grace.
- Emphasize and develop your relationship with your child long before they reach their teen years.

- Regularly communicate your unconditional love even when they are being difficult.
- Communicate clearly to your child what you are saying so that they are not ramped up emotionally by misunderstanding.
