To the Parent

This one-year (36-week) workbook is a companion volume to *Taking the Middle East for Jesus* and has been designed to span the second year of grade school. Exercises and learning activities for each chapter of *Taking the Middle East for Jesus* have been included.

Each worksheet begins with a reading from the accompanying textbook. It is recommended that children read these passages aloud so that parents can correct any mistakes or mispronunciation and assist with unfamiliar words. If children need further assistance or are not capable of reading the material on their own, parents may choose to read the textbook aloud to the child.

Spaces have been provided for children to write their answers to each question in the workbook. However, these exercises may also be completed orally rather than in written form if the parent desires. The questions included in “Think about God’s Word” have been designed so that they may be used as discussion questions or lead-ins to deeper conversations concerning the truths of Scripture exemplified in each lesson. Each child learns differently. Parents should therefore adapt this workbook to suit their child’s individual needs.

A suggested schedule is included on pages 4 to 13. This schedule divides the material in *Taking the Middle East for Jesus* into a 36-week school year based on three lessons per week. Each lesson should take roughly twenty to thirty minutes to complete. Each of these lessons include reading portions from the textbook and completion of exercises in the workbook. Another scheduling option would be to complete the reading of each textbook chapter on one day and complete the corresponding workbook pages on a separate day. Parents may utilize the schedule at their discretion and should alter or change it as best suits their individual educational plans.

“Extend the Learning” exercises have been included as optional enrichment activities. These can be completed during scheduled class time or given to the student to complete during free time. Several optional days have also been included in the Suggested Daily Schedule on which these exercises can be completed if desired.

In the Answer Key, answers to comprehension questions have been given in full sentences. Parents should use discretion in determining whether their child is comfortable enough with elementary writing skills to write their answers in complete sentences. If not, the child may provide answers in simple phrases instead.

Suggested Daily Schedule

The following is a suggested lesson schedule spanning the second year of grade school (36 weeks). This schedule is based on a school schedule in which history is studied three days per week, with each lesson taking roughly 20-30 minutes to complete. Parents should adjust this schedule as necessary to suit their family's individual needs.

Two flex weeks have been incorporated into the school year, one falling at the end of the first semester and the other at the end of the school year. These weeks can be used to catch up on missed lessons, to further the historical material studied through field trips, etc., or to finish the material early. An optional day is also included every second week which can be used to complete the "Extend the Learning" enrichment activities, to take a day off, or to catch up on missed lessons.

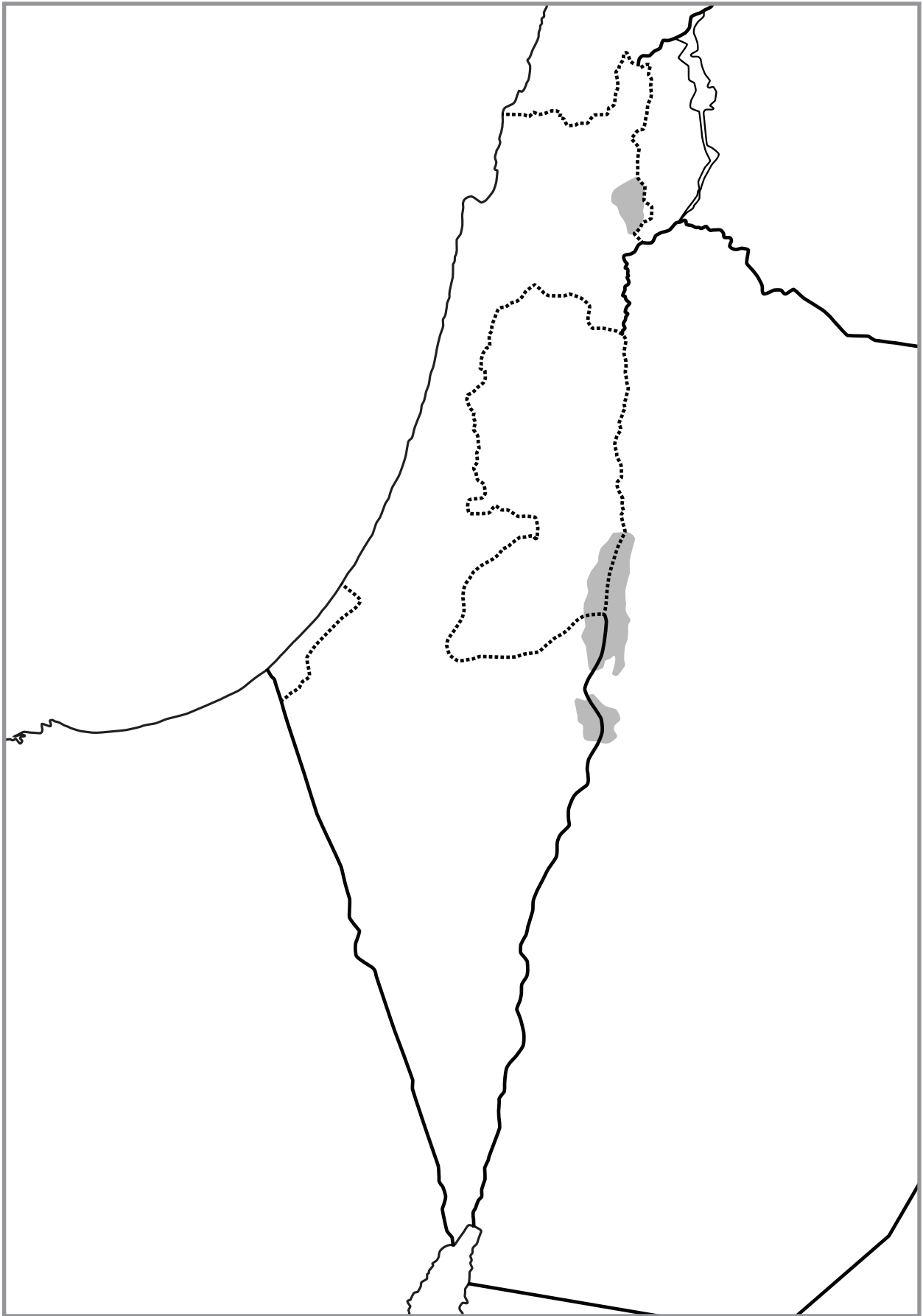
